Trademark Licensing Agreement and Other Agreements

An updated Trademark License Agreement, reflecting the Jan 8 Steering Committee discussion has been delivered to the Eclipse Foundation.

Per last discussion the draft agreement would not license the use of “Java” in specification names, and generally would limit the use of “J” acronyms that are Oracle marks or that are commonly used by Oracle or the JCP.
